

Jackie is survived by her son Joseph Burgess and his wife Hilda, of Clermont, Florida, daughters



Choose wisely: Include the types of seafood that are higher in omega-3s and lower in mercury, such as salmon, trout, oysters, Atlantic and Pacific mackerel, herring and sardines.

Keep it lean and flavorful: Try grilling, broiling, roasting or baking - methods that don't add extra fat. Spices or herbs such as dill, chili powder, paprika or cumin, and lemon or lime juice, can add flavor without adding salt.

Shellfish counts, too!: Oysters, mussels, clams and calamari (squid) all supply healthy omega-3s. Try mussels marinara, oyster stew, steamed clams or pasta with calamari.

Get creative with seafood: Think beyond fish fillets. Try salmon patties, a shrimp stir-fry, grilled fish tacos, or clams with whole-wheat pasta. Add variety by trying a new fish such as grilled Atlantic or Pacific mackerel, herring on a salad or oven-baked pollock.

Use in a salad or sandwich: Top a salad with grilled scallops, shrimp or crab in place of steak or chicken.

Shop smart: Whiting, tilapia, sardines, canned tuna and some frozen seafood are usually lower-cost options. Check the local newspaper, online and at the store for sales, coupons and specials on seafood.

Grow up healthy with seafood: Omega-3 fats from seafood can help improve nervous-system development in infants and children. Serve seafood to children twice a week in portions appropriate for their age and appetite. A variety of seafood lower in mercury also should also be part of a healthy diet for women who are pregnant or

Know your portions: To get 8 ounces of seafood a week, use these as guides: A drained can of tuna is about 3 to 4 ounces, a salmon steak ranges



from 4 to 6 ounces and a small trout

is about 3 ounces.

Keep seafood handy: Canned seafood (think canned salmon, tuna or sardines) is quick and easy to use. Canned white tuna is higher in omega-3s, but canned "light" tuna is lower in mercury.

My delicious recipe for Pasta Puttanesca With Sardines uses inexpensive jarred sardines packed in olive oil. Sardines are sustainable and are full of healthy omega-3 fatty acids. They are a nutritious replacement for es in most recipes.

PASTA PUTTANESCA WITH SARDINES

- pound linguine
- tablespoons olive oil
- medium onion, finely chopped
- (4.25 ounce) canned or jarred sardines packed in oil, reserve the oil
- cloves garlic, finely minced tablespoons Italian seasoning blend
- teaspoon salt
- teaspoon freshly ground

black pepper

1/4

- sugar 1/8 teaspoon ground cloves
- 1/8 teaspoon red pepper flakes or cayenne pepper

teaspoon stevia, honey or

- medium tomato (approximately 1/2 pound), seeded and chopped into 1/2-inch pieces, or 14.5-ounce can diced tomatoes
- (6-ounce) can pitted black olives, olives halved cross wise; or sliced, canned pitted black olives, drained
- tablespoon capers, drained, rinsed and finely chopped
- cup shredded or shaved Pecorino Romano or Parmesan cheese
- 1. In a large pot of boiling, salted water (approximately 6 quarts boiling water and 3 tablespoons kosher salt), cook the linguine according to label directions until it is al dente. Reserve 1 1/2 cups of the pasta cooking water for adding to the Pasta Puttanesca at the end of the cooking time.
- 2. In a large saute pan or skillet, heat the olive oil over medium heat, then add the onion and cook until translucent, about 3 minutes. Add sardines and their oil, then the garlic and Italian seasoning, 1/2 teaspoon each salt and pepper, the honey, stevia or sugar, cloves, the red pepper flakes or cayenne pepper, tomatoes, olives, and capers.
- 3. Turn heat to low and cook until the tomatoes are softened and the sardines are breaking apart, about 15 minutes, stirring occasionally.
- 4. Add the linguine to the pan, then pour in 1 cup of the reserved pasta cooking water, stirring well to combine all the ingredients. If the pasta still looks dry, add the remaining pasta cooking water, 1/2 cup at a time. Season with the remaining 1/2 teaspoon of salt and pepper, and the Pecorino Romano or Parmesan.



Coventry Regional Career and Technical Center (RCTC) Naval Junior Reserve Officer Training Course will, for the first time, offer a small Unmanned Aircraft System (UAS) drone course. RCTC has teamed up with the Unmanned Safety Institute to offer a training program that will allow students to obtain certification to safely operate drones in a commercial or recreational setting.

The course is a hybrid model combining classroom, online, and practical application program that, when completed, allow qualifying students to take the FAA Part 107 sUAS Certification test and obtain a certification for Visual Line of Sight Operation. Upon graduation, certified students could seek employment in the growing UAS industry. Students will also earn three college credits.

UAS is widely used by first responders to locate people in the woods, fight forest fires, and in the rescue of people in catastrophic situations. Telecommunications companies, utility companies, and construction companies for inspections that would be hazardous or difficult to complete also use UAS. Most recently, FEMA and rescue workers in the Bahamas have used UAS. Additionally, there is an increasing demand to utilize UAS for military operations.

Another exciting addition to the NJROTC program is the SeaPerch Program, which teaches students how

to maneuver underwater drones that they operate remotely. Through the SeaPerch Program, students use critical thinking and teamwork to assess a set of underwater challenges to develop a remotely operated vehicle. The SeaPerch Program provides students with the opportunity to learn about robotics, engineering, science, and mathematics (STEM) while building an underwater ROV as part of a science and engineering technology curriculum. Throughout the project, students learn important engineering concepts, problem solving, teamwork, and technical applications. Building a SeaPerch ROV teaches basic skills in ship and submarine design and encourages students to explore naval architecture and marine and ocean engineering principles. Upon completion of the ROV build, the students compete locally against their peers,

with the potential to compete nationally.

Lastly, NJROTC is proud to announce the start of their Marksmanship Team. Marksmanship offers more than target shooting; it develops concentration, discipline, focus, and responsibility. Marksmanship is a fun and engaging sport that allows the individual shooter to compete at all levels, from high school through college and even the Olympics. The Marksmanship Team will compete against other schools leading up to National shooting competitions and the potential for NCAA scholarships, as well as Civilian Marksmanship Program scholarships.
